Welcome to Sheridan Bay Park 2018

- ALL CAMPERS AND THEIR VISITORS are expected to register at the office UPON ARRIVAL
- All garbage, paper cups and plates, cans, and trash shall be disposed of in containers provided, as per recycling laws and ordinances. PLEASE TAKE YOUR BAGS OF TRASH TO THE DUMPSTER PROVIDED. Ashes will be cleaned from fire pits from time to time by the Manager.
- Do not wash clothing, dishes or utensils at water faucet or in restrooms. Water is provided at individual sites for the convenience of our campers. PLEASE LEAVE THE BACK-FLOW PREVENTOR VALVE ON THE FAUCET WHEN YOU DISCONNECT. We have provided it for your use while here at Sheridan Bay Park, not as a gift for the taking. Do not wash cars or trailers at the campsites and do not allow children to play with the faucet.
- Cutting of trees, limbs, or bushes is strictly forbidden without the consent of the Park Manager.
- Open fires shall not be left unattended.
- THERE ARE NO LIFEGUARDS ON DUTY. SWIMMING IS PROHIBITED.
- PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR CHILDREN AT ALL TIEMS, including when
 on the beach. Please do not send your kids to the beach without ADULT
 supervision. SWIMMING IS PROHIBITED.
- Pet owners are responsible for their animals. Pets are to be kept on a leash or confined and under the supervision of it's owner. A "pooper-scooper" must be used to clean up after pets at all times. Dogs are not allowed on the beach or to be left alone & tied up outside all day. NOISY PETS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. A copy of the animal's current rabies vaccination certificate is REQUIRED.
- No refrigerators, commercial coolers or any item not made expressly for recreational or camping purposes will be tolerated. Patio lights are limited to 15 bulbs. HELP US CONSERVE ENERGY!
- No utility buildings, shed or enclosures, outside refrigerators, decks or pallets will be permitted in the Park.
- Only bonafide recreational equipment shall be allowed for seasonal campsites.
 The Park Manager will use his own judgement.
- Public intoxication, use of illegal drugs, abusive or profane language, or extreme disturbances will not be tolerated. Firearms and fireworks are **not** allowed.

- Long-term (3 weeks are more) campers are expected to take care of the area immediately around their site, cutting the grass at least once a week and keeping it clean.
- Campers are requested to PLEASE STAY WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE PARK, EVEN, AND ESPECIALLY WHEN ON THE BEACH. Gathering of wood and other items from neighboring properties is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN. Repeat offenders will be dealt with by the Town Board.
- Quiet hours are between 11:00 PM and 8:00 AM. Children ages 13 and under must be at their campsites by 10:00 PM. Children ages 14 to 18 must be at their campsites by 11:00 PM.
- The SPEED LIMIT within the campground is restricted to 5 MPH. Please observe
 the speed limit for the safety of our guests and ALWAYS watch for children at
 play.
- Only one (1) table per site.
- The operation of motorcycles, for arrival to and/or departure from, the Park is allowed with minimum motor noise being tolerated. But, WITHIN THE CAMPGROUND AND ON THE BEACH, OPERATION OF MOTORCYCLES, ATV'S, MOPEDS AND MINI-BIKES IS PROHIBITED. There will be NO BIKE RIDING ALLOWED AFTER SUNSET.
- Neither the Park Manager nor the Town of Sheridan shall be liable or responsible
 for loss or damages to any personal property belonging to any camper, family
 member of a camper, invitees, or guests of any camper. Neither the Park
 Manager nor the Town of Sheridan shall be liable for or responsible for loss or
 damages to persons or property, whether by reason of personal injury or
 otherwise, sustained by any camper, family member, invitee, or guest. ALL
 CAMPERS, FAMILY MEMBERS, INVITEES AND GUESTS USE AND OCCUPY THE
 PARK AT THEIR OWN RISK.
- There will be no over-the-winter storage of campers.
- Each site is allowed 1 primary unit plus 1 screened room or pop-up canopy. Tents or other items used for sleeping quarters will result in an extra charge of \$10 per night.
